Sunday 20th June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deadline to apply for a TC if leaving WSS is Sunday 20th June. After this date the GRE is not available for late TC processing & there would be delays in processing.
Thurs. 1st July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students' last day of the academic year. Seats will not be held beyond the last day of T3 if T3 fees remain pending. Any paid Seat Booking Fee would be lost. Seats would be given to the Waiting list, & if parents decide later that they want a seat, this would be subject to availability, & not guaranteed. You may change your mind about enrolment at WSS at any time, however the seat booking fee is non-refundable (but deductible from T1 Fees, Sept-Dec. '21).
From Sunday 29th Aug. 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Start of new Academic Year 2021-2022. Students who have travelled must have completed 10 days' quarantine before rejoining school. All students over age 12 years must bring a negative PCR Test (validity 72 hours) to rejoin school.. Full T1 fees must be paid before any student has their class confirmed or admitted for the new academic year. Please Budget accordingly—there will be no Payment Plans in T1 (no exceptions). Thank you.

Pfizer Vaccination for Age 12+ Students!

We now have confirmation from Ministry of Health on the schedule for our GEMS WSS students based in Sharjah., who have already registered with us for the Pfizer vaccination.

Date: Saturday 5th June

Venue: Sharjah Expo Center

Time: 8 am – 6 pm

Ministry of Health rules are very strict, so please note:

1. Children must be 12 years and above on the day of the vaccination (a child even 1 day below 12 years is not allowed, they must actually be 12 years to get the vaccine)
2. Children should be accompanied by at least one parent (No guardians like Nanny, Drivers, relatives, etc.)
3. Children should bring their Emirates ID and WSS Student ID and should be wearing school uniform for the MOH to easily identify they are WSS school students (Passports are not allowed as a form of identification for vaccination)
4. Parents should fill and sign the emailed consent form and bring it with them to the vaccination center.
5. Parents can walk in anytime from 08am to 6pm to the vaccination center.
6. Since we have registered students officially with the Ministry of Health, it is important that your child attends this vaccination day.
7. This is only for those students who have already registered with us for the Pfizer vaccination (deadline was 26/5/21, 9am)
