Do you know which app your children are using to socialize?

What is Discord?

Nowadays children have started using a new app called "Discord" which is free, and the only cross-platform voice and text chat app of its kind, designed specifically for gamers.

It was created to replace other, voice-over internet protocol (VoIP) services by offering features that gamers love, particularly those obsessed with multiplayer online games (Fortnite, COD, Minecraft, PUBG, Among Us and many more. (Yes, it works in UAE!)

It allows users to create and join servers, channels, or chatrooms to interact with selected groups of people based on something they have in common forming a sort of "tribe."

Users can also send direct messages to other users so conversations are kept private. Our children, who are outside the gaming community, are finding this app useful and have started using it to replace Skype or Facebook Messenger. It can be used on either desktops or phones.

What do parents need to know about Discord?

It's now a massively popular app. During the pandemic, Discord exploded to over 100M members.

Privacy and limits can be customized, but... Users who create servers or channels are able to limit who can join or message people within their group. The default setting, however, is *no verification requirement at all*.

The bottom line: is Discord safe?



It can be fun if used safely and with supervision, but it feels like a high school-level app. There are always risks, especially when direct messaging options are available. This kind of app can also foster an environment of secrets, if users are not cautious.

If appropriate security measures are not taken when creating a chat group or the person is not discerning when joining a channel, there can be privacy risk. Conversations surrounding the reason for use and the types of chatrooms being used and accessed, as well as the types of servers your child would create, should be foundational when deciding if you let your teen use this app.

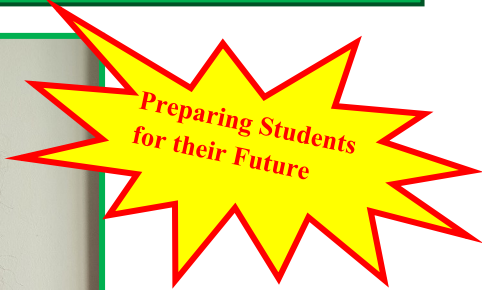


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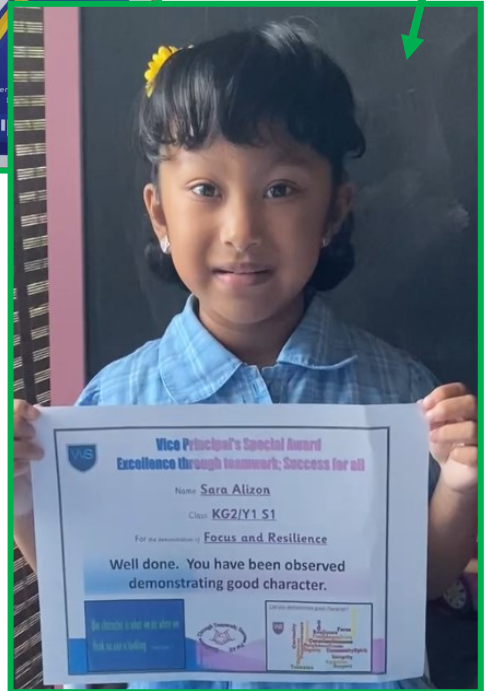

Online e-safety means to understand and avoid possible threats that you could encounter whilst engaging in activity on the Internet.

S **M** **A** **R** **T**

Stay Safe: Never give your name, address or passwords out to anyone online. They may say they are the same age as you but they could be lying!

Meet: Never go to meet someone you have made friends with online. If an online friend wants to see you, talk to an adult. Remember that they might not be who they say they are!

Accepting: If someone sends you a photo, or a file, ask an adult before you open it. It could have a virus! Don't accept it!

Reliable: Remember that you can't trust everyone who uses the Internet. Not everyone is kind. They aren't reliable.

Tell: Tell an adult if something online upsets you or makes you worried.
