NOTE: GEMS Education and WSS do not own any website/tool given in our Newsletter. Our team reviews the online tool/site, and suggest them for students and parents.

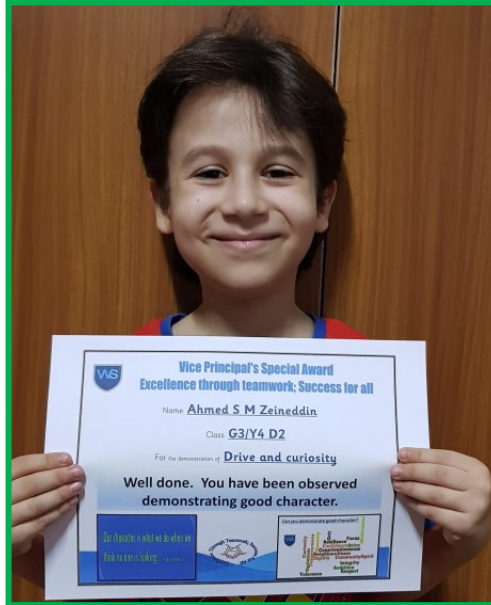
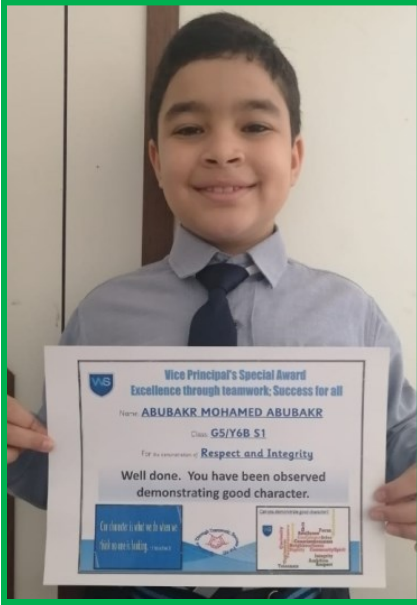

WSS Superstar Champions; EXPO 2020 Competition!



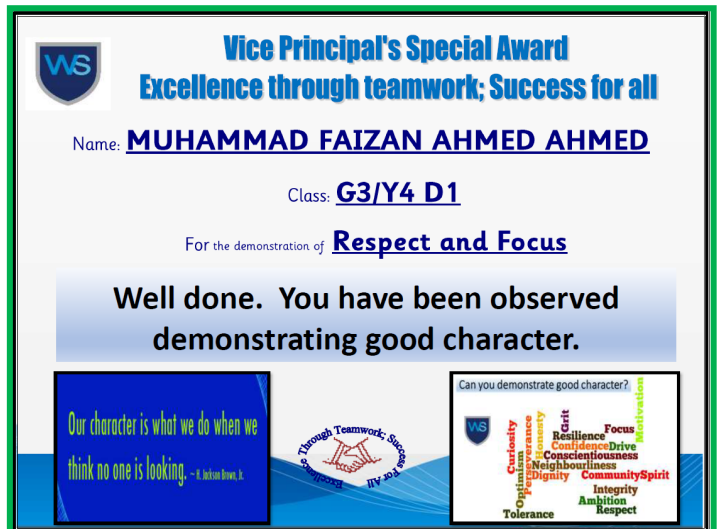

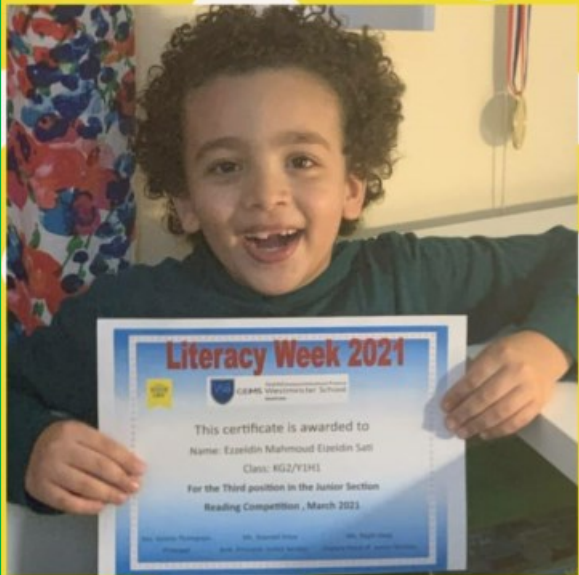

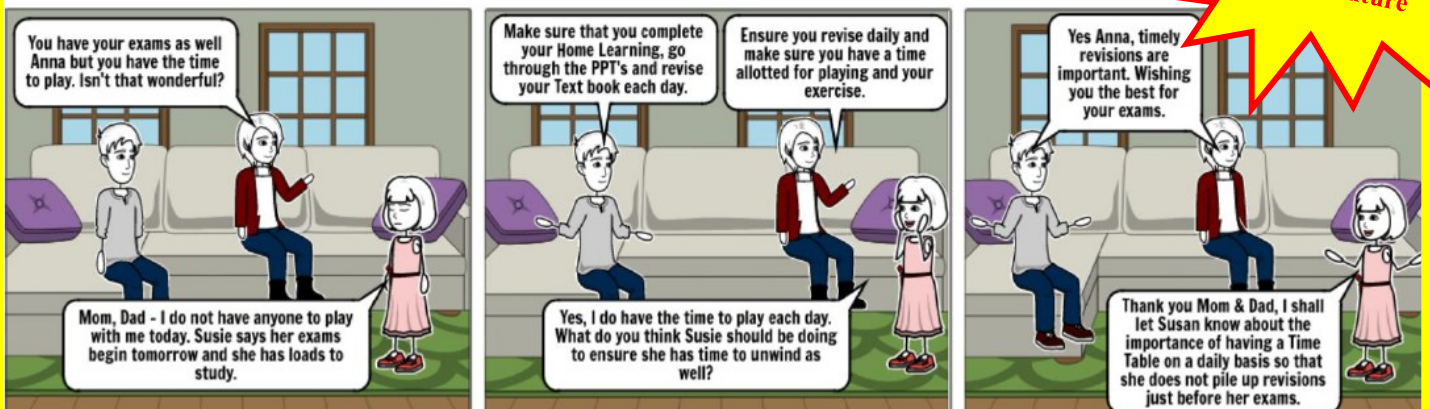
Positive Parent Partners (PPP) New Chairperson, Ms. Sadia Umair

All candidates take three components. Candidates who have completed Paper 3 and Component 5. These candidates will be eligible for grades C to E. Candidates who have completed Paper 2, Paper 4 and Component 5 will be eligible for grades A* to E.

The first mission to Mars launched by the United Arab Emirates is set to enter the planet's orbit on Tuesday following a seven-month, 494 million-kilometer (307 million miles) journey. This would make the UAE the fifth space agency to reach the red planet and mark the first interplanetary mission led by an Arab country. The Emirates Mars Mission, which has cost around \$200 million (€165 million), launched the Hope Probe from a Japanese space center.

Women paving the way in space exploration: Women make up an overwhelming majority of the mission team, according to Al-Amiri. "Our science team is 80% women. They are there based on merit and based on what they contribute towards the design and development of the mission," she told DW.

"I myself have not faced any adversity throughout my career, be it working at the space center from almost 12 years ago, all the way to becoming a minister within the cabinet," she added.
