Blended children are dropped off at school early. Please note that the school gate opens at 8:45am, so please drop your children at school after 8:45am. Thank you so much.











After this date seats will be given to the Waiting List. Seats Booking Fee can only be paid subject to clearance of full T2 fees. Seats will not be held beyond the last day of T3 if T3 fees remain pending. Any paid Seat Booking Fee would be lost. Seats would be given to the Waiting list, & if parents decide later that they want a seat, this would be subject to availability, & not guaranteed. You may change your mind about enrolment at WSS at any time, however the seat booking fee is non-refundable (but deductible from T1 Fees, Sept-Dec. '21). |
