Travel Declaration Form for September

The Authorities will require data on student travel over the summer. Therefore we will be sending home a short survey email for parents to update us on travel plans. Please complete the survey before your child returns to school from 29/8/21. Thank you.

We are Ready to return!

Plans for September's return are well-underway. We will be ready to welcome back our students for 100% F2F as soon as the Authorities give us the green light for this. Since the COVID-19 situation is still unstable, we also have plans in place incase we need to delay a full F2F programme. 94% of WSS staff have been fully vaccinated, to support the safety of your children. Let's all get vaccinated if possible to improve the chances of a speedy return to normal life!

Date	Details
Sunday 20th June	Deadline to apply for a TC if leaving WSS is Sunday 20th June. After this date the GRE is not available for late TC processing & there would be delays in processing.
Thurs. 1st July	 Students' last day of the academic year. Our learning programme will continue after exams right until 1/7/21. Seats will not be held beyond the last day of T3 if T3 fees remain pending. Any paid Seat Booking Fee would be lost. Seats would be given to the Waiting list, & if parents decide later that they want a seat, this would be subject to availability, & not guaranteed. You may change your mind about enrolment at WSS at any time, however the seat booking fee is non-refundable (but deductible from T1 Fees, Sept-Dec. '21).
From Sunday 29th Aug. 2021	 Start of new Academic Year 2021-2022. Students who have travelled must have completed 10 days' quarantine before rejoining school. All students over age 12 years must bring a negative PCR Test (validity 48 hours) to rejoin school. Full T1 fees must be paid before any student has their class confirmed or admitted for the new academic year. Please Budget accordingly—there will be no Payment Plans in T1 (no exceptions). Thank you.

Laptops or Tablets: which is better for my child?

Difference:

- Size Where do you plan on using the laptop or tablet the most? Is it at home? Is it at school? Are you
 looking for portability? Identifying the main use will help dictate the size of the device.
- Functionality Consider how you plan to use the laptop or tablet. Do you need an attached keyboard?
 Will you be researching topics or working on presentations on this device?

Which is better for homeschool, a laptop or tablet?

For students in middle school or high school, a laptop is better option to answer all their coursework needs. Laptops can do all the basics, like access their online learning service, message their teacher and submit classwork, but will also be better for writing papers and building presentations. They come with built-in keyboards and make it easy to type, research and quickly take notes while their teacher is talking, and most important of all: it is future proof!

Is it possible to control activities on Laptop/desktop?

Yes! All you need to do is create a separate account on windows for your child and keep conditions.

Which is the best laptop for a student?

Great question. Here are few important things to consider to help you identify the best laptop option:


- Screen size Will your student be carrying their laptop around in their backpack all day? If so, a smaller, lighter laptop will be more ideal. Are they remote learning this year? Then a larger screen may be more beneficial.
- Operating system Mac and Windows are the most prevalent operating systems. Mac is offered by Apple and for Windows we recommend to use Windows 10.
- Storage space Also known as the laptop's hard drive, internal storage space is an important step to
 consider. Will your child be saving large presentations or editing large video files? Consider a laptop with
 more storage space or investing in an external hard drive. Remember SSD is faster than HDD and can be
 a little expensive. But its worth the price. (SSD and HDD are types of hard drive)
- Touch or No touch- Obviously touch screen has more advantages over non-touch devices. Students can
 participate in many activities where they need to draw and write on screen.
- Cost-Your laptop cost depends on many factors:
 - Brand
 - CPU Generation: Latest is Intel 11th Gen, and AMD Ryzen 3rd Gen
 - Storage drive type: HDD or SSD/512 GB or 1 TB
 - Type of laptop: Gaming laptop cost more than normal

Apart from this laptop cost and speed depends on two main factors:

A. RAM : higher is better (8 GB /16 GB/32 GB)

B. Processor

- INTEL i3 suitable for typing and surfing web
- INTEL i5 suitable for office work and online lessons
- INTEL i7 suitable for gaming and video editing
- INTEL i9 suitable for heavy work and multitasking
