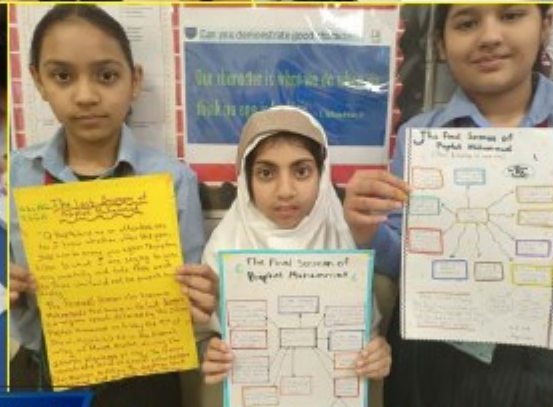
Rabi-ul-Awwal Activities in the Primary Section for Years 3 to 6.
