
- Once classes with maximum student numbers are filled, the option will be removed, or we may ask students to choose an alternative.
- Only complete the ECA choice link once payment has been made.


#### Key Points:

- Parents pay on GEMS Parent Portal under "Activities". (please do not pay in tuition fees).
- After payment parents can use this link to enter their child's student details and ECA Choice: https://forms.office.com/r/3gUnhDVhZ6 (use child's eLearning account details to access the form).
- 3. Students will be allocated activity groups on the first day of ECA Programme.
- Every Wednesday of the 6-week ECA programme, students will be guided to the Auditorium at the end
  of the school day.
- Teachers will come to the auditorium; register and then escort their students to the allocated activity area (maximum 25 students per teacher).
- Students participating in sports can either wear their P.E kit to school or bring it with them and change at school (younger students are advised to wear their P.E kit and come).
- 7. Our ECA activities end at 4:15pm. At this point BBT students are taken to the auditorium and make their way to the bus area once they are ready. OT students will be dispersed from the OT areas as usual (please do not come into the auditorium).
- Please note we expect students to continue with their chosen ECA activity for the 6 weeks as each
  programme is designed with learning outcomes over this period.
- Some of the sessions (e.g. Foodies or AI and Robotics etc.) have limited spaces. Once these are filled, we will remove this option on the form.







# Secondary Section News; Attendance & Punctuality On Report Programme; for Character & Life Skills Development!

#### Dear Parents/Guardians,

#### Subject: Student Success; Leave, Attendance and Punctuality

As a school, we believe that character development & life skills are the cornerstone of a student's success, both now in school & beyond into their future career. Accountability, responsibility, self-discipline, smart time management & punctuality are some of the critical life skills that lead to future success & are reinforced in school.

To support our students to develop these critical life skills, in the coming Terms we are **prioritizing punctuality & attendance at school.** Not only does coming to school late or taking invalid absences result in disrupted learning, but it also teaches poor character traits.

From January 2025 we will be implementing a 'Punctuality & Attendance On Report' policy that will align with our existing Behaviour Policy.

#### 😊 Expectations of School Attendance and Punctuality

- Regular Attendance: Students are expected to attend school regularly unless they have an
  approved, valid excuse (e.g., medical certificate, bereavement, Hajj/Umrah, or an authority
  appointment).
- Class Attendance: Students must attend all scheduled lessons on time, without exception.
- Punctuality: Students should arrive at school no later than 7:15 AM.
- Early Exits: taking Early Exit disrupts learning & should be avoided unless in an emergency

#### Criteria for being put on 'Attendance and Punctuality On Report'

- Attendance below the threshold of 95% (without valid reasons).
- Frequent Lateness: A student is late three or more times in two consecutive weeks.
- Unexplained Absences: Accumulates two or more days of unexplained absences in a month.
- Frequent Early Exits; More than two per Term.

#### 'On Report' Programme Guidelines

Students placed on the "Attendance and Punctuality On Report" programme are required to adhere to the following:

- Visit the Success Center at the start of each Break for a check and signature (non-compliance may result in the loss of privileges (e.g., PE or team practice) or break detention).
- Maintain and complete the "Attendance and Punctuality On Report form during each lesson.
- Parents must sign the 'Attendance and Punctuality On Report' form daily.

 Show the 'Attendance and Punctuality On Report' form to the Section Leadership/as designated Team each morning.

Getting to school on time takes teamwork; we kindly request your support in reinforcing these expectations at home. Together, we can help our students learn from their mistakes, take responsibility for their actions, and grow into better versions of themselves.
