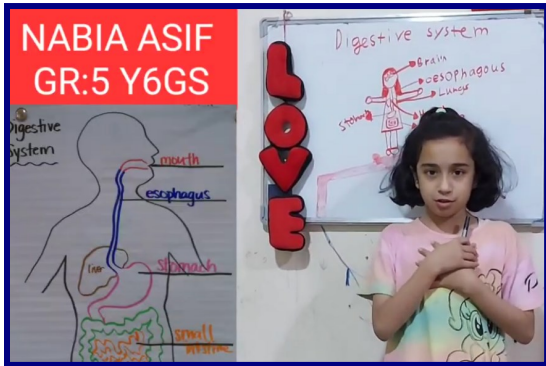

TIMSS 2023 was the eighth cycle of TIMSS.
